


# Don't Flush That!

Attention Sewer Customer,

A recent sewer backup in the city found many disposable wipes and rags in the sewer main. Please do not dispose of cleaning wipes and rags in the toilets. Many wipes *claim* to be flushable but they do not break down like toilet paper and get lodged in the sewer main causing backups.

Here is a list of items to keep out of the toilet;

- disposable diapers
- tampons and tampon applicators
- sanitary napkins
- cotton balls and swabs
- mini or maxi pads
- condoms
- **ANY KIND of wipes including cleaning wipes, baby wipes, & flushable wipes)**
- facial tissue
- bandages and bandage wrappings
- automotive fluids
- paint, solvents, sealants and thinners
- poisons and hazardous waste



## Unused Medications

Do not flush unused medications down the toilet. You can safely dispose of medications in the drug collection unit in the lobby of City Hall at 116 E. Market St.

## Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG)

Grease in sewer pipes causes sewer maintenance problems for property owners and the city. Never pour grease in your sink drain and try to use your garbage disposal less.
