

## Storm Clean Up Notice

**August 4, 2022**

Due to the high wind event on August 3, 2022, the City of Troy has activated the limb pick up policy for affected residents. Please visit [www.troyil.us](http://www.troyil.us) or call 618-667-9924 for details. **Limb pick up will end on August 11, 2022 at 3:00 pm.**

## Limb Pickup Policy


- The City of Troy will provide a limb pickup program after a storm-related incident.
- The City of Troy will make a determination to pick up limbs based on the severity of storm damage.
- Residents will be notified via the city website that the limb pickup program is activated. Residents can also call 667-9924 ext. 2 for information regarding limb pickup after a storm.
- This pickup is intended for isolated fallen limbs and not fallen trees; disposal of entire trees is not permitted.
- Limbs should not be more than 8 feet in length and should not be more 6 inches in diameter.
- **Limbs should be placed within 4 feet of the curb or roadside but not more than 8 feet from the curb and must be placed parallel to the roadway.**
- Residents have seven (7) days after the storm to place their limbs at the curbside following notification.
- **Residents must call 667-9924 ext. 2 to be added to the list for limb pickup.**
- **Public Works will make one pickup per household.** Thereafter, disposal of limbs and brush must be done through Republic Waste (using yard waste bags) on trash pickup days, or residents may hire a tree trimming contractor to handle the disposal.
- This policy is for residents in the city limits of Troy. No pickup will be done outside the City limits of Troy.
